FISH OF WESTMINSTER, INC was established in 1970 by a group of Westminster
Christians who were called to express their love and concern for their neighbors. FISH has evolved into multiple programs addressing food insecurity our neighborhood. FISH of Westminster is a partnership between Westminster
Presbyterian Church and Westminster
United Methodist Church. Major funding is provided by the cities of Westminster and Thornton and donations from neighbors like you!

Clients experiencing homelessness are provided food, water, and personal hygiene items as well as items such as gloves, socks, hats, and scarves. 960 clients were provided support in 2022.

Diapers for infants and toddlers. Food pantry clients are provided diapers and baby wipes upon request each month. 55 clients were provided diapers and baby wipes.

Food pantry clients are helped with food essentials once a month. They are provided sufficient food to feed their family 10 meals including fruit, vegetables, meat, peanut butter, soup, pasta, and cereal. Diapers, hygiene products and pet food are also provided.

37 dedicated volunteers worked 1,650 hours to keep the food panty running.

5,442 clients from SW Adams County were served from the food pantry (a 13% increase over 2021).

54,420 meals were provided.

464 meals from the Holiday Food Bags.

65,000 pounds of food were distributed.
